### **Earth Citizens' Assembly Legitimacy through strength in numbers**

+ As the number of people declaring their Earth Citizenship grows, so too will the legitimacy of the decisions made by Earth Citizens' Assemblies.

### **Peoples' Assemblies in every town.**

+ [Peoples' Assemblies](#) will be networked globally, teaching critical thinking, systemic thinking and the use of empathic debating tools to create and share local action plans. Where possible, held out in the open.
